

To All the devotees of Sri Gururaghavendra and Sri Anjaneya Swamy,

I wish to inform you that we the members of Sree Gururaja Sevasamithi and devotees of "Sree Harivayugurugalu", have taken up the mission of "Jeernoddhara of 500 year old "Sree Anjaneya Swamy Temple" at our native place called Theertham (Ananda Theertha Agrahara during Guru Sree Vysaraja Period).

As part of the process, the following have been accomplished:

1. With the blessings and initial donation of Rs.5001 from Sreepadarajaru of Mulbagal Mutt, Narasimhatheertha, Kolar District (near Theertham) the project has been launched during 2007
2. **Swarnarooda Astamangala Prashna** was conducted during June 2007 with the guidance and presence of Udupi Tantrigalu called Sree Muralidhara Tantri and his Team following the principles of Tantrasara written by Shreemadacharyaru, in order to spiritually ascertain the significance, history of Theertham and the temple and processes to be followed to conduct the Jeernoddhara Krama. 3. As prescribed by the Tantrigalu, we had conducted required cleaning /remedial processes and homas and started temple renovation work during 2008-09
4. Main blue print and plans have been prepared by Sree Narayana Tantri who is also a temple architect and advisor of Sri Pechavara Swamigalu
5. Sri Dineshrao, Civil Engineer, Architect and Director of Cruthi Consultants Consortium, Bangalore and his team have been rendering relentless voluntary and wholehearted service for drawings and construction of the temple from the day one.
6. Temples are being built in South Kanara Udupi/Dharmasthala style and Architecture adopting Aya etc as per Tantrasara/ guidance of Tantrigalu.
7. As of today, we have completed the following:
 - a. Old dilapidated structure has been safely removed duly safeguarding unshakable "**Mukhya Prandevara Moola Vighraha and Rayara Brindavana**" in a temporary steel structure housing them with closed doors enabling daily minimal pooja, abhisheka etc.,
 - b. Civil Construction of One Main temple, Garbhagiha for "Mukhya Prandevara Moola Vighraha and Rayara Brindavana" and two small temples for Ganesha and Subrmanya also have been completed
 - c. Finishing works, such as floor granite tiles, wall cladding, Theertha Katte, electricity/water works, painting etc will be taken up after main front prayer hall for devotees is completed.
 - d. Ashwatha Katta Platform housing Ashwatha Vrikshas, Nagarakallugalu (to be reinstalled) has been leveled and renovated outside the temple complex
 - e. Mani Prayer hall measuring about 40'x40' -1600 sq.ft has been commenced, pillar foundation, plinth beams, 16 columns of 11' height have been completed and Main roof of the hall is proposed to be commenced soon.

f. After finishing the main hall and Nagara/Ashwtha Katte works, we need to cleanse and renovate Sarovara which is also in a dilapidated condition.

Apart from finishing the project, we also need to create a good corpus, i.e. Moolanidhi for temple maintenance activities perpetually.

All these days we have toiled, pooled and collected small streams of funds from humble devotees all over, and managed to reach this stage. Now we are badly in need of funds to come in a big and good way from overseas devotees like your kind self to complete the main prayer hall and pending works of Jeernodhara as mentioned above.

We need atleast about Rs.10 lakhs, immediately to complete the first phase of this sacred and beautiful temple complex project conceived by our Engineers with the guidance from Sree Muralidhara Tantri and Sree Narayana Tantri of Udupi.

We hope and trust that you will come up in contributing to this cause in liberal and generous manner, with the blessings of [Harivayugurugalu](#).
